

Dear beloved sponsors and donors,

I have just returned from hosting a team of Americans visiting our Dream Centers in India. What a great time of ministry! Worship, teaching, encouragement, laughter, travel adventures, heat and rain, and of course – the kids, the lepers and their kids, the High Risk girls – what a diverse and delightful group. Our team was elated!

Recently, the Holy Spirit spoke to me while I was reading about Cornelius in Acts chapters 10–12. In Acts 10:4, the angel said to Cornelius that his prayers and his alms had gone up for a memorial before God. That really got my attention. Our GIVING TO GOD goes up to Heaven's throne room and speaks to God on our behalf. And the Lord notices and responds. That spurred me to increase my own giving to the work of God.

Secondly, in that same story, (verse 6) the angel instructs Cornelius to send for Peter who will tell Cornelius what he must do. Why didn't the angel just tell Cornelius the message of salvation? Why bring Peter all the way from Joppa to Caeserea? Aah... it is because the task of telling and making disciples is the mandate given to Christian men and women. ### TWO NEW DREAM CENTERS

We are opening a new Dream Center in Malkangiri, at the southern tip of Orissa. This is a region that is truly at the bottom of the State in more ways than just geography. The current issue of one of India's leading magazines, described this area as the worst in all of India. Neglected and exploited, Malkangiri is a harsh place inhabited by thousands of tribal people. In that barren desert, we are opening an Oasis, a shelter, a place of hope.

Good News India is also opening an SECOND HOME for our High Risk girls in Siliguri. 20 new girls are joining us by the end of May. I went to "interview" them.... How does one "interview" a darling 9 year old who has no clue where she was headed and is all caught up in playing and discovering her new world? All the girls "passed the interview"!! I know God's people will come alongside us to take care of them.

#### **ACADEMICS**

While in India, I personally went over the grade/report cards of all our kids in grade 8 on up. While many are struggling due to their impoverished backgrounds and late start in education, a great number are absolutely excelling. Most are headed to College or Bible College. (For the same \$25/month). We are setting academic standards for these kids to reach, because a good education is their sure ticket out of poverty and we will work diligently towards that end.


